

Harvey Frederick "Fred" Waller President of the Association in 1994

Harvey Frederick Waller "Fred" passed away Friday October 12th Wake Medical Center in Raleigh, NC. Mr. Waller left this earth surrounded by family. He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Phyllis Moore Waller and three children.

Fred spent his entire adult life in service to others. After graduation from North Carolina State as a Military Honor Graduate he went on to serve in the Navy and Air Force in numerous roles reaching the rank of Lieutenant Colonel before retirement after 34 years. Known by some of his peers as "the God of Asphalt," because of his long and distinguished career as asphalt engineer, Waller worked with the Asphalt Institute of Raleigh where he rose to be one of its most sought-after employees due to his tremendous knowledge, intuition and expertise in his field. Fred was also the President of the Association of Asphalt Paving Technologists (AAPT) in 1994-95. His unyielding dedication to his profession kept him working regularly as a consultant two decades after formal retirement. Waller gave numerous certification lectures to engineering students at universities up and down the east coast and was constantly in demand as an expert witness in cases involving his field.
